TO BE PART OF THE WORKING GROUP
ON ACCESS TO INFORMATION AND TRANSPARENCY
Organizations and Individual Members

The Latin American Association of Archives, at its General Assembly on January 28, 2021, approved the official creation of a Working Group on Access to Information and Transparency (GTAIT). It is a technical body whose main objective is to create a multidisciplinary collaborative environment among the Ibero-American archival community, where the study and development of regulatory changes and their impact on transparency and access to information are addressed, from the perspective of records management, being a theoretical reference framework, both for archive professionals and legislators when working on these matters, and especially for citizens in the exercise of their rights.

To be part of the Group, the participation of organizations and professionals in these fields is necessary, preferably those who have specialized knowledge in these issues, or who have notable expertise and experience related to access to information, including the treatment of official secrets, transparency and open government, or the protection of personal data.

First. Members and Requirements

ALA members interested in participating must submit:

Organizations:

- a) Letter of recommendation and/or designation of a representative of the same justifying their participation, experience in the subjects and merits.
- b) A list of outstanding actions in favor of access to information and transparency.

Individual members:

- a) Curriculum vitae that preferably demonstrates specialized knowledge or experience in the aforementioned field (teaching or research).
- b) Letter of reasons (from 1 to 3 pages) in which they state the reasons why they wish to belong to the Group, as well as their interests and expectations of the Group (free format).
- c) Copy of current affiliation certificate as a member of ALA.

Second. Documents reception

The reception of the documents is between February 15 and March 15, 2023. No application will be accepted after the date.

Third. Presentation and address for sending the application

The documents must be sent in PDF format, by email to the account: gtaitala2023@gmail.com

You will receive an email confirming receipt of the documents.

Fourth. Results

The results will be published on Friday, March 17, 2023, on the microsite <https://www.alaarchivos.org/gtait/>

In the event of not being selected, your contact information and merits will be kept in a database for possible future integration as invited expert members.

Fifth. Committee

For the review and opinion of the applications, a commission integrated by the presidency of the ALA, the coordination and the technical secretariat of the GTAIT is formed.
